

Guidelines for Group Preparation and Communal Consecration

- A group needs a leader to organize the meetings and discussions.
- There will only be Six (6) Group Meetings (not daily).
- For communal consecration, the Group will decide the Act of Consecration Prayer to Saint Joseph and if done in a Church must be recited before the tabernacle or in front of the image or statue of Saint Joseph.
- If the communal consecration is done outside the Church, the Act of Consecration must be recited in front of the image or statue of Saint Joseph

Third Group Meeting - (Days 9 -15) - April 13, 2023

O St. Joseph, I never weary of contemplating you, and Jesus asleep in your arms; I dare not approach while He reposes near your heart. Press Him close in my name and kiss His fine head for me and ask Him to return the kiss when I draw my dying breath. St. Joseph, patron of departing souls, pray for me. Amen.
